Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Just a few reminders about your daughter's confirmation next week:

- The girls traditionally bring in money (€2 -€5) for the local **St. Vincent de Paul**. This is presented at the Offertory, during the Confirmation ceremony. Please ensure that this is in school by Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April at the latest. We have provided an envelope.
- **UNIFORM** As in previous years your child may make her Confirmation in the uniform of her second level school or in her primary uniform if you prefer. Some girls make it in their Girl Guide or Scouts uniform. However, all girls must wear a uniform on the day.
- Please ensure you are seated in the church by **10.45** at the very latest. There is always a large crowd so I would advise that you get there as early as possible to ensure you get a seat.
- There is **no parking** inside the Church gate. It might be advisable to park down town, or in nearby car-parks
- The **Parents' Councils** of both schools agreed in recent years that the practice of exchanging cards in the Church is to be discontinued. This has not taken place in recent years and has been of great relief to many families.
- **All** girls in Sixth Class will have a **half day** from school on **Wednesday 03<sup>rd</sup> April (12.30 pm)**. Please ensure you collect your child at this time. If you are unable to collect your daughter, please advise us in advance and she will be accommodated in another class.

Enjoy the preparations for the "big day".
